Restoration Award Guidelines

The intent of the restoration Award is to recognize those people who have done a complete restoration of a vintage car. The restoration work must be tastefully done using colors, fabrics, accessories etc. which are in keeping with the era of the vehicle. Items or changes which enhance the safety of the vehicle will not deter from the vehicle's eligibility for an award, however other modifications from original will not be accepted.

Applicants will be required to make arrangements to have their vehicle viewed by the committee members to insure the requirements of the Restoration Award are met.

Completed application forms must be in the possession of a committee member no later than the regular June meeting to receive recognition in that year.

Areas to be considered.....

1. **BODYWORK** - Remove as much rust as possible and rework all metal in preparation for painting. Body must be removed to insure complete cleaning for preservation.
2. **BRIGHTWORK** - Repair, replating or polish to as new condition.
3. **INTERIOR** - Interior mats and upholstery either replaced or returned to original standards
4. **PAINT** - Vehicle must be repainted.
5. **RUNNING GEAR** - Engine, driveline and suspension must be disassembled, inspected and necessary parts repaired or replaced in order to place the running gear in as close to original condition as possible.
